Dunedin's Supper Club stands out as the largest annual gathering, attracting 1,000 attendees who generously offer their support. Over the past 14 years, an astounding \$2.5 million has been raised for RMHC New Zealand.



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How the evening works...

Guests are invited to purchase a table for ten people, and at the pre-dinner function one guest can choose an envelope to find out the name of the dining destination – a moment of great anticipation for all involved.



Lion Pre-Dinner Function 5.00 pm - 7.30 pm

The evening kicks off with drinks and finger food at the Town Hall, where guests will discover their dining destination. It's a chance to reconnect with familiar faces whilst learning about the impact of RMHC Houses for families with a child undergoing hospital treatment. The Lion pre-dinner function culminates with an exciting live auction and continuation of the online auction offering numerous chances for everyone to participate.

The Surprise Dining Experience 8.00 pm - 10.00 pm

Guests will be hosted by a fabulous dining destination who will provide a delicious meal for their guests to enjoy.

Nobody knows which dining destination they are going to until the actual night of the event. As a result of this the dining destination may not be able to cater for dietary requirements e.g. celiac diet - if you and/or guests have a dietary requirement please advise the restaurant prior to arrival.

Note, if you are going to a venue the caterer will have a set menu and will most likely be unable to accommodate any dietary requirements.



The After Party 10.00 pm onwards

Guests are invited back to the Octagon and are warmly welcomed to finish the night with a night cap or two at Vault 21.

You and your table guests are more than welcome to join us at the after party function.



TABLE SALES

Each table of ten guests can be purchased for \$2,000.

A \$600 contribution goes to your dining destination to help towards expenses.

BEVERAGES

Some dining destinations may choose to provide complimentary drinks on arrival or a bottle or two for the table otherwise guests pay for their beverages.

Note some dining destinations are unable to provide a BYO experience due to licencing restrictions. Should your table be drawn to go to one of these dining destinations, we kindly ask that you purchase your drinks from the establishment.

All BYO dining destinations are restricted to wine and beer only - no spirits are permitted. Upon arrival your host will take the beer and wine and serve it to your table throughout the night. Any leftover beer or wine will be returned to you at the end of the evening.

DRESS CODE - COCKTAIL

* Cocktail attire is a balance between formal and casual and elegant and comfortable. For men suggestions include a suit with a shirt, dress shoes and a tie or bow tie. A blazer and a pair of dark-coloured trousers is also acceptable. For women cocktail wear includes dresses and heels, two-piece ensembles.
