RMHC New Zealand is our country's leading family charity, and by adding them to your charitable portfolio, your company or business is joining a large community, which extends from the families they have taken care of, to their supporters and volunteers.

Annually Supper Clubs have collectively raised over \$1,000,000 with the Dunedin event contributing to over **\$400,000** towards this figure. All of these events have a significant long term impact on many families across the country.

NZ families receive support and accommodation from RMHC New Zealand every year.

At 32 weeks pregnant Maddie and Mackenzie found out that their unborn child, Maya, had a perforated bowel and one week later Maya was diagnosed with cystic fibrosis.



Maya was born at 35 weeks via emergency C-section - on her first day of life, Maya was wheeled into surgery. There will be an ongoing need for medical treatment, but are so proud of Maya and her resilience.

During this challenging time Ronald McDonald House became their lifeline. "It really is a home away from home during what has been the worst time of our life".

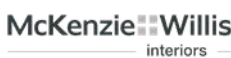
